Preschool Program

Thank you for your interest in Central Lutheran Preschool. We would like to share some basic information about our program and hopefully answer some of your questions.

Central Lutheran Preschool admits students of any race, color and national or ethnic origin.

Our program is theme-based with a *learning-through play* approach to name recognition, letters, numbers, colors and shapes using books, songs and hands-on activities. Children will also learn social skills to aid in a successful kindergarten experience. We support parents in their role as the primary caregiver and teacher of their children. We serve children ages 3-5 years old. Class time is from 9:30 - 12:00 p.m., Monday - Thursday. You can choose to enroll your child in two, three or four class days per week.

We offer an extended-day supplementary class two days per week beginning in October for those children planning to enter Kindergarten the following September. This is an addition to the regular preschool experience, and is available at the discretion of the preschool teacher. The focus is on math skills, pre-literacy and Kindergarten readiness. Extended day will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 12:30-1:45.

As a parent co-operative preschool program, parent involvement is required. This means that each family has the opportunity and responsibility to assist in our classroom *twice per month (for children attending 2 days per week)* or *three times a month (for children attending 3-4 days per week)* as a teacher assistant. You may be asked to work an extra day during months that are five weeks long. During the year, community building opportunities include: family festivals, fundraisers, and family work parties. Each family contributes ten work hours a year through their help with the fundraisers or work parties. Our every other month parent education meeting is mandatory, and offers shared support in a parent community, including parenting techniques and current research on early childhood development. Families can also serve on a fundraising committee or on the board.

Our program is a non-profit, self-supporting, community-based program. Financially, we operate with monthly tuition, enrollment fees and fundraising. There is a \$75.00 non-refundable enrollment fee. Tuition is dependent on the number of days your child attends. The two day a week program is \$125 per month, the three day a week program is \$140 per month, the four day a week program is \$160 per month. If your child is ready for extended-day, monthly tuition for this additional 2-day program is \$75 per month.

On Wednesdays and Thursdays, the class attends 15 minutes of optional chapel time with the pastors of our church. This is a non-denominational, developmentally appropriate few minutes for spiritual growth. We also include a monthly field trip to explore and enhance our understanding of community.
